- 3) Share about a trial you’ve faced recently.
- 4) Is it possible to be joyful when facing trials or difficulties? Why?
- 5) Why is prayer so significant when seeking God’s will?
- 6) Why do many Christians choose comfort over loving the forgotten? How can we guard against that tendency?

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## GOING DEEPER

READ – **I Corinthians 13:4-7** together

- 1) What is something that jumps out at you from this passage?
- 2) According to this passage, how is love described?
- 3) How does this love differ from the type of love the world props up as the ideal?
- 4) Why is it important to understand what love is before offering it to the forgotten?

READ – **Jeremiah 17:7-8** together

- 1) On a scale of 1-10, how much would you say that you trust God? Why did you give yourself that number?
- 2) What are the benefits of trusting in God?
- 3) If God promises that we will thrive regardless of externalities, why don’t more people pursue God’s mission for their life?
