GROWING CLOSER TOGETHER

- 1) What is your favorite Christmas carol?

MESSAGE REFLECTION

- 1) What is something from the sermon that stood out to you, convicted you, or encouraged you?
- 2) What have you seen as the biggest hurdle for yourself or others to reading the Bible?
- 3) Which translation of the Bible do you prefer? (NLT, NIV, ESV, NASB) Have you ever considered another version? What about a paraphrase like the Message?

GOING DEEPER

<u>READ</u> Ephesians 2:8-10 together using the "Semantic Relationship" approach.

<u>Comparison</u>: like, also, as, in the same way, etc

Contrast: But, however, then again, etc

Conditional: therefore, if, then, so that, for, etc

Take note of these words to help group phrases together and see their relationship with other grouped phrases.

<u>READ</u> **Proverbs 1:1-7** together and use the Inductive Method of Bible Study to help understand this passage. Observe, Ask Questions, Answers(Context), Application Questions (on back)

Read **Psalm 37:39** together using the "Pronounce It" method. Highlight each word of the verse and unpack what these words means.

LIVING IT OUT

Use one of the above methods this week as you study the Bible.

PRAYER TIME – Pray for the needs and requests in your group.

Bible Reading Application Questions

What does this passage teach me about <u>God</u>? What does it say about <u>mankind</u>? Is there a <u>sin</u> highlighted here that I need to repent of? Is there a <u>command</u> I need to obey? Is there a <u>promise</u> I need to hold on to? Is there a <u>principle</u> I need to learn from?
