- 2) How's your prayer life? What obstacles keep you from praying?
- 3) On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your community? Why?
- 4) Why is accountability such an important component of community? How does it promote active faith?
- 5) Looking at the accountability questions on the back of this page, which would be the top 3 questions that would be helpful for you to be asked?
- 6) Why is community so important to God?

GOING DEEPER

READ – **Hebrews 10:24-25** together

- 1) How are “meeting together” and “love and good deeds” related?
- 2) Share about a moment in your life that you were encouraged in your faith by someone else. Are you encouraged regularly by others? Why or why not?

READ – **Ecclesiastes 4:9-12** together

- 1) What is something that stands out to you from this passage?
- 2) How is this applicable when it comes to your faith?

JOHN WESLEY'S ACCOUNTABILITY QUESTIONS

(Feel free to add your own)

- Am I consciously or unconsciously creating the impression that I am better than I really am? In other words, am I a hypocrite?
- Do I pass on to others what has been said to me in confidence? Have I participated in gossip?
- Can I be trusted?
- Am I a slave to appearance, friends, work or habits?
- Am I self-conscious, self-pitying, or self-justifying?
- Did the Bible live in me today?
- Do I give the Bible time to speak to me every day?
- Am I enjoying prayer?
- When did I last speak to someone else about my faith?
- Do I pray about the money I spend?
- Do I get to bed on time and get up on time?
- Do I disobey God in anything?
- Do I insist upon doing something about which my conscience is uneasy?
- Am I defeated in any part of my life?
- Am I jealous, impure, critical, irritable, touchy or distrustful?
- How do I spend my spare time?
- Am I proud?
- Is there anyone whom I fear, dislike, disown, criticize, hold a resentment toward or disregard? If so, what am I doing about it?
- Do I grumble or complain constantly?
- Is Christ real to me?
