- 3) Does this give you confidence in your prayers? Why?

READ - 2 Corinthians 12:7b-10 together

- 1) What is something that stands out to you from this passage?
- 2) Scholars have debated for years exactly what Paul's thorn in the flesh was. Whatever it was it was a heavy burden to Paul. How do these verses teach us how we ought to pray & respond when it comes to difficult circumstances?
