MESSAGE REFLECTION _____

- 1) Review the main points of the message and share something that stood out to you or inspired you.
- 2) What attribute of God is easiest to understand? What is the most difficult attribute of God for you to understand?
- 3) Why should you always maintain a healthy fear and reverence of God?
- 4) What is a covenant? What does God's desire for a covenantal relationship with us teach us about God?
- 5) How does God's offering his people grace **FIRST** change how we should view his giving of the law **SECOND**?
- 6) Read **Exodus 20:1-5** together....Why is God's jealousy for our worship a good thing?
- 7) What is God's desire when it comes to the *why* behind following his commands and laws?
- 8) Share from your experience the difference between rule-based obedience and relationship-based obedience.

READ – Psalm 103 together

- 1) What jumps out at you from this passage that is interesting or thought-provoking?
- 2) Make a list of all the descriptions of God's works and character traits in this passage.
- 3) How do these works of God compare with what is expected of us (vss 11, 17-18)?
- 4) How is praising God the opposite of forgetting God (vss 1-3)?
- 5) What specifically were God's ways and deeds that were made known to Moses & the people of Israel (vs 7)?
- 6) Share some of the good things has God done for you.
