- 2) What do you value most in your friendships?



### MESSAGE REFLECTION \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) Share about something from the service or message that stood out to you, inspired you, or encouraged you.
- 2) Read **Galatians 2:11-17, 3:1, & 3:19** together. What jumps out at you from these verses?
- 3) What was Peter doing that was so egregious according to **Galatians 2:11-21**?
- 4) How can devoted followers of Jesus be led astray (see **Colossians 2:8**)?
- 5) Why does the desire to follow Jesus sometimes cause people to add duties and teachings to the Gospel? Have you ever been guilty of doing that or observed this happening? Share.
- 6) What is the only way you can be made right with God (**Colossians 2:13-17, Galatians 3:1-6**)?
- 7) Referencing **Romans 8:1-4**, how is Love, Grace and Truth shown to us through Jesus' death on the cross?
- 8) How does this contrast with the world's understanding of love?

READ 1 John 4 together

- 1) What jumps out at you from this chapter that is interesting or thought-provoking?
- 2) How do you know whether a particular teaching or spirit is from God?
- 3) Why is knowing God necessary when it comes to discernment? What are you doing to know God better today?
- 4) What does God's love look like? What did God's love do for you and me?
- 5) How does the gospel simplify what it means to be a follower of Jesus?
- 6) What does it look like to truly "love your brother (and sister) in Christ"?



## LIVING IT OUT \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) What are some things you've added to the gospel? Ask God to forgive you and to help you simply abide in the simplicity of the gospel.
- 2) Meditate on and consider memorizing **Ephesians 2:8-9**.
