CLOSER TOGETHER

1) What is your favorite hero story?

2) What is one word or phrase you would want to put on your tombstone.



MESSAGE REFLECTION

1) Share something from the service or message that stood out to you, inspired you, or encouraged you.

2) Read **Daniel 3** together. Does anything stand out to you from this passage as it relates to the message?

3) Why did Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego not bend their knee to Nebuchadnezzar's statue? What would you have done in that situation?

4) How does today's culture pressure you to bow your knee and compromise in order to go along with it?

5) Share about a time you've experienced God's abiding presence in the midst of a furnace situation. How did it change you?

6) How does seeing someone do bold things for God strengthen or encourage you?

7) Why do people avoid furnace situations? Is this your tendency? Why or why not?

GOING DEEPER_

READ Romans 8:31-39 together.

1) What is something from this passage that stands out to you?

2) What effect does the statement question in verse 31 have on your faith?

3) What does Paul mean in verse 32 when he says that God will graciously give us all things?

4) How does God counteract condemnation and accusations against his children?

5) What is the reality for those following Christ according to verses 35-36?

6) Have you ever lost anything because you took a stand for Christ or the Truth of the Bible? If so, what did you gain?

7) What does it mean to have victory in Christ (vs 37)?

8) How does knowing that God's love is constant and always present give you confidence in facing troubles, hardships or persecution?

KK LIVING IT OUT

1) Pray this prayer every day this week - "God, give me a chance to prove my love and devotion to you."

2) Share with someone outside of your group how God has met you in the furnace and what effect it had on your faith.
