GROWING CLOSER TOGETHER

- 1. Tell about a difficult hiking or travel experience you've had. What was the biggest challenge you encountered?
- 2. When was the last time you exhibited courage?



MESSAGE REFLECTION_____

- 1. Review the main points of the message. Share something from the service or message that stood out, challenged or encouraged you.
- 2. Read **Mark 1:14-18** together. What jumps out at you from this passage?
- 3. How is Jesus' call to repentance and belief different from simply believing that God exists and different from simply affirming things about God or his word?
- 4. What are "grazers?" How are they different from the sheep Jesus describes in **John 10:27**?
- 5. What is the goal of discipleship (reference Ephesians 4:22-24)?
- 6. How best can you determine what the next step in your faith journey is?
- 7. Why is it so easy for people to graze or coast on their faith journey?
- 8. How can you guard against apathy as you try to follow Jesus?



READ Luke 9:20-25 together.

- 1. What is one thing that jumps out at you from these verses?
- 2. After Peter declared his belief that Jesus was the Messiah in verse 20, why do you think Jesus chose that moment to talk about his impending death and resurrection?
- 3. Why is denying yourself vital on the discipleship journey?
- 4. How have you obeyed Jesus' command to "deny yourself" (v 23)?
- 5. What does Jesus mean when he tells his disciples to "take up your cross daily"?
- 6. Is it possible to fulfill Jesus' command to "deny yourself" and "take up your cross daily" but not follow him? Why or why not?
- 7. How does giving up your life for Christ result in true living?
- 8. How have you experienced truly living by dying to yourself?



- 1.Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to show you what your next step is. (Some options: investigate Jesus, decide to follow, baptism, new believer class, godly habits/disciplines, join a small group, serving, membership, read entire Bible, prayer, memorization, mission trip, generous giving, leadership, discipling others, sharing my faith)
- 2. Tell someone what your next step is and trust God as you pursue that next step!
