7. Have you ever experienced a short-term “revival-like” moment? Share about it.
8. Why is it important to evaluate revival by long-term fruit rather than emotional moments or attendance numbers?

3. Why is prayer such a central part of any movement of God?

READ 2 Chronicles 7:14 together.

4. What conditions do you see connected to spiritual renewal in this passage?
5. Which of these is hardest for you personally to live out? Why?
6. How might humility and repentance prepare the way for revival?

READ Galatians 5:22–25 together.

7. What kind of "fruit" does the Spirit produce in a person's life?
8. Why is lasting fruit a better measure of spiritual health than emotional experiences?
