- Need one? We got one. Let your leader know.

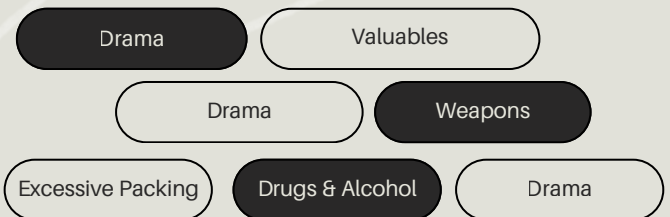
WEATHER GEAR

Travel Information



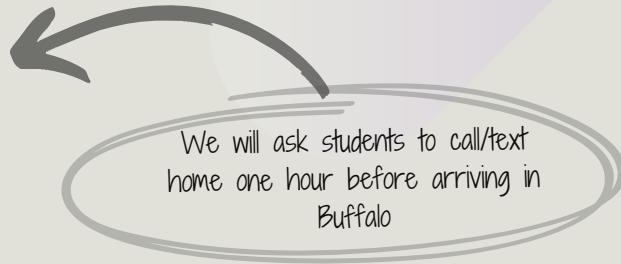
- Students will need to bring cash for food during transportation
