MESSAGE REFLECTION _____

1. Share something from the service or message that stood out, challenged or encouraged you.
2. Why do you think it's easy for people or cultures to slowly drift away from God? Why can it happen faster than we expect?
3. Why can it sometimes feel discouraging to live faithfully in today's culture?
4. Why does restoration begin with God's Word and not just more effort or trying harder?
5. What difference does practicing faith as a covenant, rather than just beliefs, make?
6. What makes it hard to let go of things that compete with God?
7. What do you think most often keeps people from fully surrendering to God?
8. How can one person's courageous faith actually influence others?

READ 1 Kings 18:15-39

1. What is something that jumps out at you from this passage?
2. What do you notice about how Elijah prepares before calling on God?
3. Why do you think Elijah poured water on the sacrifice before calling on God? What might that reveal about his faith?
4. What differences do you observe between how Elijah approaches God and how the prophets of Baal act?
5. What do you notice about how the people respond after God reveals Himself?
6. Why do you think the people were silent earlier in the passage but decisive at the end?
7. Why is it important to clearly distinguish between the true God and false gods? What is one example of this in our culture?
8. What does this passage show about the connection between obedience and God's power?

2. Where might God be calling you to step out with courage this week?
